

Catharine Magdalene Weber was born on December 14, 1893, in Jasper County Illinois the daughter of Dennis Weber and Maria Darsch. She was baptized at Holy Cross Church on December 24, 1893 by Rev. Marcus Roth with Godparents John Kessler and Elizabeth Weber her Uncle and Aunt.

Catharine was raised in the Holy Cross Parish along with her siblings Matilda, William, Oscar, Joseph, John, Anna, Albert, Frank, and Eugene.

She would make her First Communion at Holy Cross on June 3, 1906 and received the Sacrament of Confirmation on September 24, 1907 conferred by Bishop John Janssen at Holy Cross.



Catharine left home at the age of 16 to be a nun. She entered the order of the Poor Handmaids in Fort Wayne, Indiana and took the name Sister Hermana. She was at the Mother House less than a year when she became ill with typhoid fever and died on December 24, 1910. She is buried at Holy Cross.
